

## Christmas Party Loyalty Scheme.



Anybody is welcome to attend the South Lincs DA Christmas party, but in order to receive a gift from Father Christmas donated by South Lincs DA, we are running a camping loyalty scheme. Children under the age of 16 at the date of the party are eligible to join the scheme.

Under the Camping and Caravanning club rules a unit is classed a '2 adults and up to 4 children'. Therefore a unit is able to register up to any **4 children** for the loyalty scheme (they may be your children, grandchildren, or other children you may care for).

Once registered each child will be issued with a loyalty card.

Every time that child camps in your unit for the weekend they are eligible for a stamp on their card. It is your responsibility to ask the steward to sign the cards for the children that have **camped overnight** with you in your unit.

To be eligible for a gift from Father Christmas, the child must have **completed 5 weekends of camping** and the card should be completed to this effect and **handed into the committee by the Bonfire Meet**; thus allowing time for the organisation of the presents.

If the card hasn't been completed and/or handed in on time then the child can still attend the Christmas party but South Lincs DA will be unable to purchase the present. Their accompanying adults however may wish to purchase a gift that Father Christmas will then present at the party.

Please note that the first weekend eligible for the loyalty scheme is New Year. Each subsequent weekend up to and including the Bonfire Weekend (30<sup>th</sup> October – 1<sup>st</sup> November 2015) are eligible. **Attendance at a temporary holiday site is considered to be one stamp regardless of the number of nights attended during the temporary holiday meet.**
